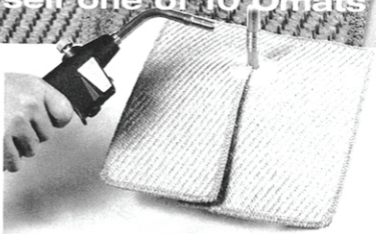

The principle features of Omat are as follows:

- It is a patented high temperature soldering mat for plumbers;
- It has a hole, slit and overlap which is simply applied around 15 and 22mm pipe for all around protection;
- It is made from fibreglass with flameproof stitching and can be used in all soldering situations up to 600 C.

Roger Bisby's verdict on Omat:

"Simple enough, but I didn't think of it and I weep because it was so obvious. Even if I had had the Polo inspirational moment, I doubt I would've thought to add the little overlapping flap at the back which closes the gap. The mat is high quality with good heat resistant stitching. The idea has been taken up and marketed by Monument Tools. The inventor is still banging in kitchens patiently waiting to recover his £80,000 investment in patents and development costs. Perhaps I should be glad I didn't think of it. He deserves his success and he is a top bloke too."
